This compact is an agreement between you, your Offender Manager and the London Community Rehabilitation Company. This compact sets out your rights and responsibilities during your time on Licence or serving a Community Order or Suspended Sentence Order.

What you can expect from **us**

- To see you on time for an appointment, or explain any delay to you
- To treat you in a fair and respectful manner
- To work with you to identify your reasons for getting into trouble
- To become aware of ways to help you stay out of trouble
- To respond to your needs and work to reduce any risks you pose, whatever your background
- To explain and share information with you about your progress
- To record your success
- To treat information we have about you with confidentiality, where appropriate. However, if you share information about your offending or risk to other, which causes us concern, we have a responsibility to share that information with other agencies, including the Police and Social Services.

What we expect from **you**

- Not to commit any crimes
- To attend on agreed days and on time
- To tell your Offender Manager at once if are not able to attend
- To supply good reason with proof, for any failure to attend.
- To work with and follow your sentence plan
- To report on time and not under the influence of drink or non treatment drugs
- To actively join in your unpaid work and with any help offered you
- To treat staff and other service users with respect
- Not to interfere with the supervision of other offenders
- To join in reviews of your progress and talk about areas of your life which can help you stay out of trouble

- To let Probation staff visit your home as required
- To inform your *Offender Manager* in advance if you change your address
- To agree to information about you being given to other agencies as appropriate, which can assist you to address your crime-related needs after your *Community Order* or *Licence* has finished

If **you** fully comply with this compact you could gain from the following:

- A say in your sentence planning and reviews of your progress
- Entry to suitable change and support programmes
- A certificate of attendance
- A certificate of completion
- The chance to gain useful qualifications
- Support in managing your money, transport, housing, education, training or employment
- References or proof of identity for services you need
- A record of your success
- A chance to have your order positively looked at by a court

If you **fail to meet the terms** fully with this compact you could find:

- You are returned to court or returned to prison
- Your supervision requirements are made harder
- It may be more difficult to provide the help and support you require.
- You are disciplined and are given a verbal or written warning
- You may be removed from some probation activities or have to start them again

You are required to behave well, show respect and take responsibility for your actions and progress while under supervision.

During your sentence you will be asked to read, sign and comply with other compacts that are to do with certain programmes, interventions and privileges. These compacts will have a set of different expectations you must follow as well as (not instead of) the expectations on this *Offender Compact*.

This Compact is a voluntary agreement between you and the London Community Rehabilitation Company. You do not have to sign it to gain access to the benefits it offers. However, if you fail to comply with the terms of the Compact you may be subject to the action outlined above.
